**Evaluating Foreign High School Diploma for US Equivalency
Suggested Vendor Services and Pricing Information**

Effective, Jan. 1, 2016, per NACCAS regulations, accredited institutions must “have evidence that verification of a foreign student’s high school diploma has been performed by an outside agency that is qualified to translate documents into English and confirm the academic equivalence to a U.S. high school diploma.” (Standard IV, Criterion 1D)

This is not an official form approved by the Department of Education, SCHEV, or NACCAS. This form was created as a guide for students enrolling at The Chrysm Institute of Esthetics and the information below is subject to change.

The following companies below are members of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services. It is recommended that students purchase the “General Evaluation” service. **Note: Translation services may be charged separately or not offered. The following list is primarily for US Equivalency evaluations.**

Documents may be mailed to the student and submitted with application or may be mailed to the school. Translated and evaluated diplomas are required prior to formal application to The Chrysm Institute of Esthetics.
